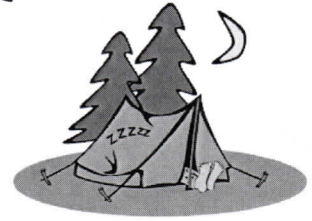


Lighthouse Family Camp 2020

(CAMP REGISTRATION begins Sunday, July 26)

(Check in anytime after 1pm on Friday.)

Location: Harmony Hill Youth Camp

(Please click the link on the campground's website to see the map. Putting the above address in a map app will NOT take you to where the camp is located. If you go to the roundabout in Fulton and take the exit that goes past ACE Hardware, continue on out Rte O for about 9 miles and the camp will be on your left.)

Out at Harmony Hill, we will have access to a fully-equipped commercial kitchen which is why all meals will be provided this year. But due to this, we will need more help in the kitchen for set-up, meal prep, and clean up after each meal. We are asking that at least one member of your family unit volunteer at least once during the weekend and we will happily welcome more help if you can manage! All of our meals will be shared inside together as a church family!



A schedule for meals will be coming out later in the month.

FEES: There are lodging fees and also Day Use fees that the Camp requires. Day Use fees are charged for those staying overnight AS WELL AS those just coming out to the camp for the day. The cost \$5/day per person over 5yrs old. But meals are provided once you arrive! Please don't miss out!!!

Motel rooms are equipped with their own full bath, queen bed(s), as well as air conditioning and a mini-fridge.

Lodging Details: Harmony Hill has several options! You will need to pay when you reserve your spot for your family. All rooms and sites are first come first served.

Full Hookup Campsites - \$25/night

Campsites with/without Electricity for tents on grass (Bathrooms/showers are available in the main building.) - \$5/night

Motel Rooms equipped with 2 Queen beds and a full bathroom - \$20/night per room

Motel Rooms equipped with 1 Queen bed, a sofa bed, and a full bathroom - \$20/night per room

Miscellaneous Details:

- Coffee & Water will be provided. Feel free to bring any other drinks for your family if you'd like.
- You are welcome to bring sides that need refrigeration. There is a large walk-in one there we can use. Please label your items. You will be responsible for prepping your sides before dinner.
- Feel free to bring snacks for your family. Please label them if you put them in the fridge.
- Please bring Lawn Chairs for Saturday and for Sunday morning service.
- If you are staying in a motel room, you need to supply your own sheets and pillows (there is a bedspread), as well as bath towels, shampoo/conditioner, deodorant, etc.
- Parents with little ones: Please bring pack-n-plays and any other items your little ones may need for sleeping and playing.
- There is NO POOL at this Camp.
- There is a playground, but if your child is playing, YOU MUST supervise your child.
- There is plenty of grassy areas (including a baseball diamond) to play games on Saturday! Feel free to bring balls and other games or equipment to play and invite people to play with you!!!
- Feel free to bring boards games to play with others during the day if you'd like.
- No animals are allowed in the buildings. If you bring a trailer, you may keep your animals at your campsite.
